

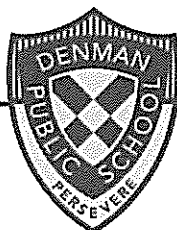
ITINERARY for Stage 2 Dubbo Excursion

TUESDAY 20TH NOVEMBER, 2018:

- **ARRIVE AT SCHOOL AT 8.15am**
- 8.30 am SHARP depart Denman Public School, (coaches will arrive at 8.15 a.m. to LOAD) and we will travel via the Upper Hunter town of Merriwa viewing the large open cut mines with a stop at Cassilis to view the Aboriginal Caves then through Gulgong.
- Lunch (brought from home) at a suitable time and location.
- At 1.00pm students are booked to visit the Wellington Caves.
- We then travel to Dubbo and proceed to check into Taronga Western Plains Zoo.
- BBQ Dinner at the Zoo
- Night Tour - visit the Education Centre for an Animal Encounter Get Up Close with a range of native Australian animals and search for them by spotlight.
- 9.00pm Supper and off to bed for a good night's sleep.

WEDNESDAY 21ST NOVEMBER, 2018:

- 6.00am breakfast at the Zoo & checkout.
- 7.15am an early morning walk - go 'behind the scenes' at the Zoo. Approx. 9.00am Guided Bus Tour where a guide will take students around the Zoo circuit.
- Approx. 11.30am Early Lunch (supplied by the Zoo) at a suitable location.
- Dubbo Gaol - where students are booked for a guided tour at 1.15pm.
- Approx. 3pm board the coach for return to Denman Public School to arrive back at school at approximately 6.15pm.



WHAT TO PACK

Students must bring a backpack as a day bag, as well as an overnight bag (they must be able to carry this on their own). Please ensure all items are labelled with student's name.

- Packed recess, lunch and afternoon tea for the first day
- 2 casual, comfortable and cool outfits (with sleeves)
- Joggers/sneakers to be worn each day
- Jumper or jacket
- 2 pairs of socks
- 2 sets of underwear
- Suitable pyjamas
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, conditioner, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, hairbrush)
- Pillow and pillow case
- Sleeping bag and a fitted or flat single bed sheet
- Bath towel
- School hat
- Raincoat
- Drink bottle
- Sunscreen
- Torch

Optional:

- Souvenir money (maximum of \$40 in total). Must be in a secure labelled wallet or envelope. This money is the student's responsibility.
- A reading book or other small game for the bus
