## SCHOOL SWIMMING and WATER SAFETY PROGAM

Dear families,

Arrangements have been made to include a learn to swim program in our school curriculum. The Department of Education School Swimming and Water Safety Program is an intensive learn to swim program, which develops water confidence and provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival. The program is conducted over ten days. Each daily lesson is 30 minutes.

The School Swimming and Water Safety Program is for ALL students in Kindergarten, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3. Students in Years 4 to 6 who identified having not reached a satisfactory standard of water safety and survival skills, and are unable to swim 25m confidently and unaided in deep water, are eligible to participate in the School Swimming Scheme.

Instruction will take place at Denman Swimming pool. The program will continue daily over two weeks. Dates for the intensive swimming program are as follows: Friday 23rd November (Week 6) Monday 26<sup>th</sup> November – Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November (Week 7). Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> December – Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> December (Week 8).

**Pool entry** will cost \$2 per day. The cost will be \$20 overall for the program. Students holding a season pass are not required to pay pool entry. Due to the value of this program, if any families require financial support, please contact Mrs Druitt.

Each child should bring a swimming costume, towel, hat and school tracksuit on a cool day. As our instruction takes place in an outdoor pool, it is recommended that students use adequate sun protection, eg. an SPF 30+ broad spectrum, water-resistant sun screen reapplied regularly.

A rash shirt is **compulsory** to participate as this aligns with the schools sun safe policy. If your child does not have a rash shirt, a t-shirt that covers their shoulders will suffice.

Students will be assessed during the School Swimming and Water Safety Program for all water safety skills **WITHOUT** goggles. Please complete and sign the note attached and return to the office.
