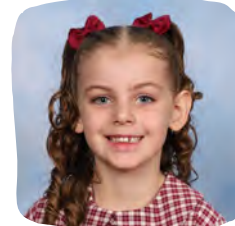

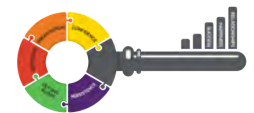

Caleb - Consistently demonstrating kindness and inclusion, always checking in on his friends.



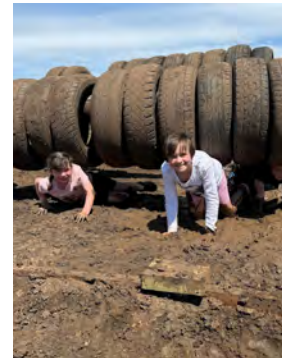
### RICKY RESILIENCE

Roy - Adapting to challenges and new activities at the Stage 2 camp with a positive attitude.

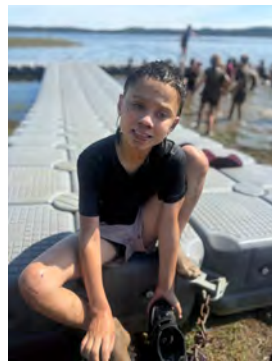
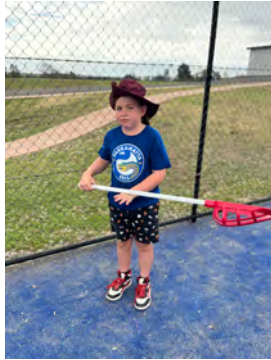


# LAKE KEEPIT

Layla

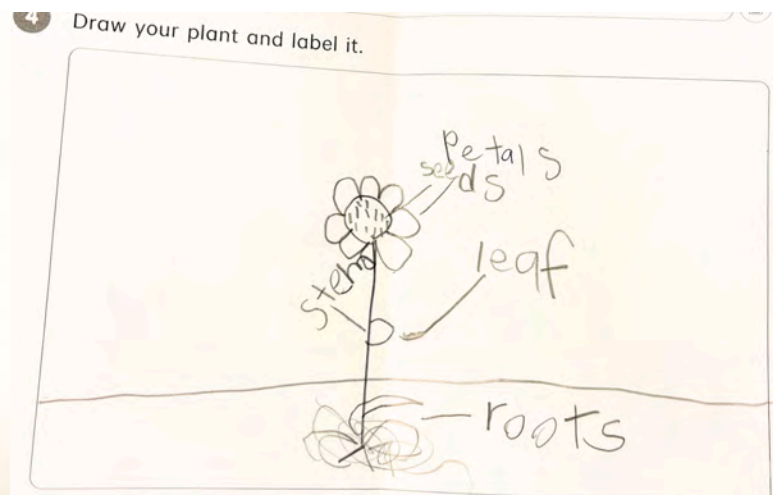
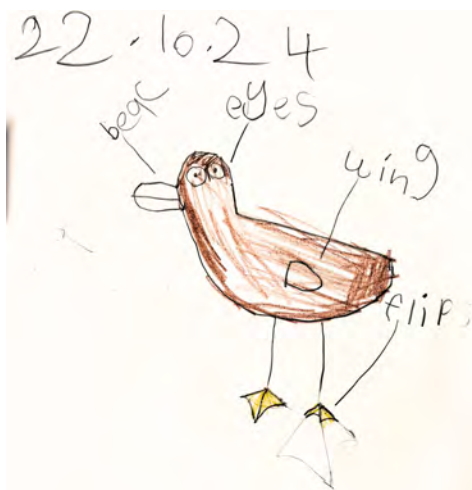
Kindergarten have been working on building their independence in writing. Layla successfully responded to the writing prompt to construct a matching sentence. Great work!

In Science, Year 1 are learning about the external features of living things. Caeden drew this animal and plant, labelling it correctly. Well done Caeden!

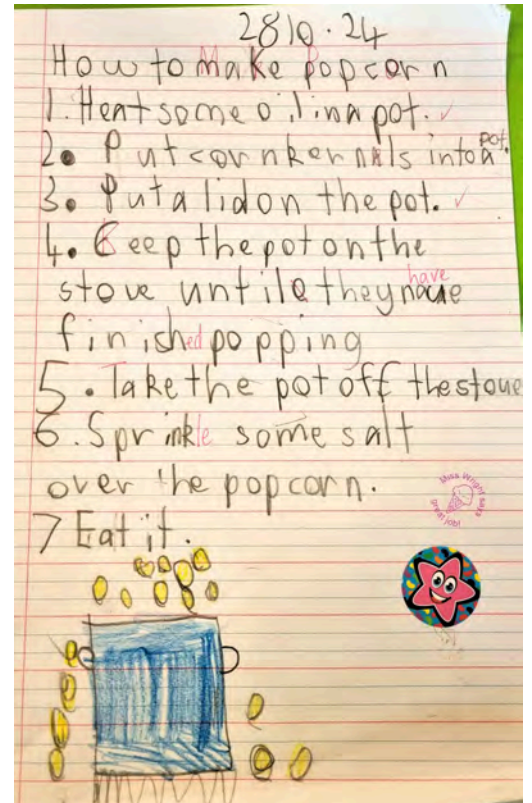


# WONDERFUL WORK
